from Oct 7th

New Spin on an Old Conversation. Hebrews 1.1-4; 2.5-12

Times change. Technology continues to develop and transform our lives, whether for good or to our demise. I often look at the idea of transport and how much it has changed. The technology packed into new cars these days is frightening. Sat nav is now pretty much standard. Cruise control, self-parking and other functions make our drive more reliant. No more having to stop and fill the radiator. But one thing never changes. That is the vehicle's purpose. To move one or more people from A to B. Cars still have a resemblance of cars, but different knowhow driving them. It's a bit like God's promises from Old Testament to New. God spoke to His people the Hebrews directly or through Prophets. That worked for the time, but God's plan went beyond Prophets and Sacrifices. They were for a time, until God completed His covenantal promises, through Christ. The conversation has always been the same as such. God has always entered into covenants of one form or another with His people. God has always cared about the state and well being of those who turn to Him in Faith. The new spin to use the term has been around sacrifice, repentance and salvation. A sacrifice must be about taking the life of something physical as atonement for someone. In verse 5 of chapter 2, the author clarifies this: *It is not to angels that he has subjected the world to come...*

It must be something physical offered as a sacrifice. And so, Christ was born. Born to die for our sins. Jesus' physical death, wrapped up with his heavenly attributes, meant he could take sin to the pit for all who believed on his name. No Angel could accomplish this. New Spin! – **Revd. Tim**
