from Dec 2nd

It has become apparent to me that the term 'God ordained' is losing its respect in both secular and church. I get it that the secular world doesn't want to acknowledge what is set into play by God. By getting it, I mean that if they were to accept it, then they would not be secular. What happens when the church, turns its back on the God ordained givens of this universe.

Some Christians question the authenticity of the Bible, stating that it has surpassed its use by date, and needs a new coat of paint for a new generation. Self appointed (and opinionated) little people think they have the correct take on God's Word for a new world. But one thing they have totally overlooked, or more to the point, ignored, is that God is timeless. His Word is timeless. The word given to the prophets of old is still surfacing and coming to light today. The words given to these prophets, such as Jeremiah, were clear. In the verses preceding the reading from Jeremiah, God spoke: 'This is what the Lord Almighty says: 'In this place, desolate and without people or animals—in all its towns there will again be pastures for shepherds to rest their flocks. In the towns of the hill country, of the western foothills and of the Negev, in the territory of Benjamin, in the villages around Jerusalem and in the towns of Judah, flocks will again pass under the hand of the one who counts them,' says the Lord.' Yes, Israel is again a place like it used to be. Putting politics aside, it is a vibrant land as promised. War did not stop it regaining its life. Our readings today begin with 'in those days'.
